ELIGIBILITY

Members, 27 years of age or under on the 1st September, 2020 and full members of a YFC Club based in Wales and affiliated to either Wales YFC or NFYFC. Competitors must hold either a full Driving Licence or Tractor Licence, **which a copy/image is required to be emailed to Wales YFC along with a copy / image of their certificate of competence in ATV Handling.**

Competitors will be required to send a copy/image of their current membership card to the office.

PROCEDURE

To create a video on the theme 'ATV Safety Advert'.

The 1 minute video should focus on Quad Bike Safety for Agricultural use.

Health and Safety must be adhered to in the video.

The entertainment and informative value of the video will be taken into consideration by the judges.

Videos will be accepted in Welsh, English or bilingually.

Members will also have to complete a timed questionnaire (no more than 10 questions) on safe operation / health and safety of the ATV. The Questions will be completed via Kahoot. A link will be provided following the receipt of the video entry.

TIMING

Maximum time allowed for each video is one minute.

The video may be presented as a series of short clips, animation etc.

Maximum time allowed for the questionnaire is 10 minutes.

PONITS TO NOTE

A full handover of the bike by Quad Bikes Wales would need to be completed with the winner.

The winner will need to insure (proof will be required) the ATV. Quad Bikes Wales will conduct the first service FOC but then any further services or damage will be chargeable.

The winners will be expected to post pictures on social media over the twelve months and if head shots are shown, they must be wearing a helmet. If photos appear in social media without a helmet, the ATV will be collected by Quad Bikes Wales due to breach of Health and Safety.
