Natural Resource Wales (NRW) have created an innovative game to highlight the importance of sustainably managing our natural resources, focusing on exploring how animals are adapted to their environment and what they need to live

The Game...

A guessing game, aimed to develop individuals knowledge of insects and animal features, behaviours and habitats.

How to play

This game can be played in a range of ways.

- Read out the "Who am I?" cards one at a time, and see if anyone can guess the creature represented.
- Stick a picture of an insect or animal onto the back of each individual, so that the card can be seen by the rest of the group but not the individual. Working in pairs or small groups, group members take turns to ask questions about its creature features, getting yes or no responses only from others. Can they work out what the creature is from the answers?
- Divide the group into pairs and alternate between questioner and guesser.
- Ask the group to sit in a circle. Give each individual a card, explaining that you do not want them to look at the card. When everyone has got a card, ask those with the picture cards to look at their cards ensuring no one else can see it. Choose someone with an information card to read the clues out loud to the rest of the group. The rest of the group can guess which creature the clues refer to. Once a pair is identified, peg them up next to each other on a line.
