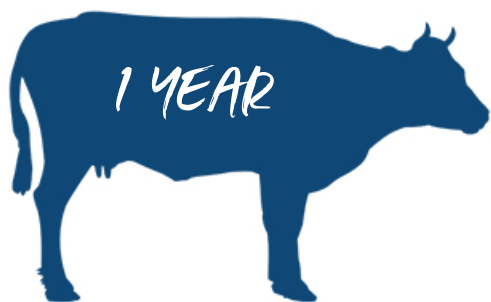

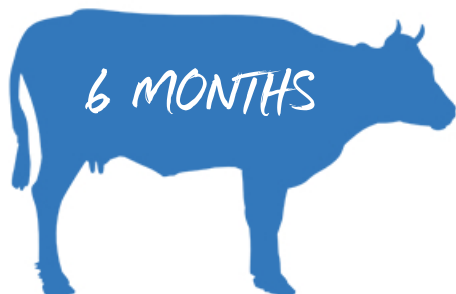

The programme up to 12-months allows students to experience a full season on a NZ dairy farm to ensure they can take home every aspect of dairy farming in New Zealand. Completing this program will give the valuable knowledge that will be beneficial for a dairy career back home and internationally.
