## C/57/1921 WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

It was noted that each County has two voting reps, more members per County can attend however only two members can vote.

Katie explained that tonight's meeting was to discuss any queries relating to the virtual Public Speaking and to make further arrangements for the Virtual Royal Welsh Rules, discuss the Cywain Competition and to discuss a weekend festival competition.

### C/59/2021 TO CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

## C/61/2021 CORRESPONDENCE

a) An email was received from Kate Thomas, Glamorgan YFC:

Hi Claire and Rhodri

Please can you add Tug of war to the agenda for the next wales comps meeting? NFYFC has asked if we can discuss direct entry for NFYFC Tug of war and not have an area round

It was noted by Kate Thomas that a further meeting had been held since Kate had sent this email to Wales YFC, and NFYFC has postponed their Tug of War competition for June until at least September/October time. NFYFC had asked area's to go back and get some feedback on the Tug of War competition for the next NFYFC meeting.

An email had been received by NFYFC regarding Tug of War and that team's associate with the TOW Association can resume to train. Members were unsure on if teams in Wales could resume training with guidelines in Wales noting that only under 18 can resume training in various Sports. It was agreed that the Welsh Tug of War association should be contacted, and this should be on the next Competitions Meeting Agenda.

### C/62/2021 TO DISCUSS FUTURE COMPETITIONS

### a) Virtual Public Speaking Weekend 2021

Katie Court noted that entries had been received by Wales YFC on the 29/03/21 and work was ongoing to complete the Public Speaking programme to be circulated to Counties.

It was asked whether the Committee had any preference on what days the Situations Vacant and Member of the Year interviews should be during the weekend. It was agreed that Wales YFC should fit these interviews in where they see them fit between the Public Speaking competitions.

### b) Virtual Royal Welsh 2021

Katie Court noted that during the last meeting, discussion was held regarding the Virtual Royal Welsh Show 2021 and the rules noted last time had been circulated prior to this meeting.

The floor was opened for a discussion regarding any questions/queries.

It was noted that some Counties had concerns regarding the Stock judging and the breeds that had been chosen, including finding Welsh Speaking judges and also finding pictures and videos of the breeds. After a discussion it was agreed that Wales YFC would be contacting the breeds society to ask if they would be willing to support in providing pictures/videos and also finding judges especially Welsh Speaking judges.

The Committee also had thought and agreed on alternative stock – in case any breed would not be able to accommodate the Committee's query regarding judges and stock. The Committee agreed that the Committee

Officials and Wales YFC would look back to past stock judging competitions and choose a breed that was done 4 or 5 years ago to use for this year's Virtual Royal Welsh.

It was also agreed that the Stock judging competitions would be done on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2021, with the competition running on Zoom. All competitors would see the still images the same time and be put in to breakout rooms for their reasons.

The Committee agreed that the Chairman's Generation Game would be held on the 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2021.

- 8. Cookery Members will be given one food item and they will then need to make any meal including that item. Competitors to be given this item, in which they will have 10 days from the receipt of the item to submit what they have done by video/photos etc + recipe list. £20 spend.

- 10. Craft To commemorate the Welsh Air Ambulance 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary
- 11. Upcycled item Not to use the same item as 2020.

#### c) Cywain Competition

Katie Court noted that she and Nia Lloyd had joined Cywain in various meetings in the last few weeks. A document was shared on the screen with the Competitions Committee members regarding the Cywain Competition which will be released in May.

Katie explained briefly the Competition noting that Cywain would like members to create and present a new, innovative menu using Welsh food and drink produce local to them.

Katie also noted that Cywain was keen to hear if the Competition Committee had any suggestions regarding a #hashtag for the competition. After a discussion, some suggestions were noted:
