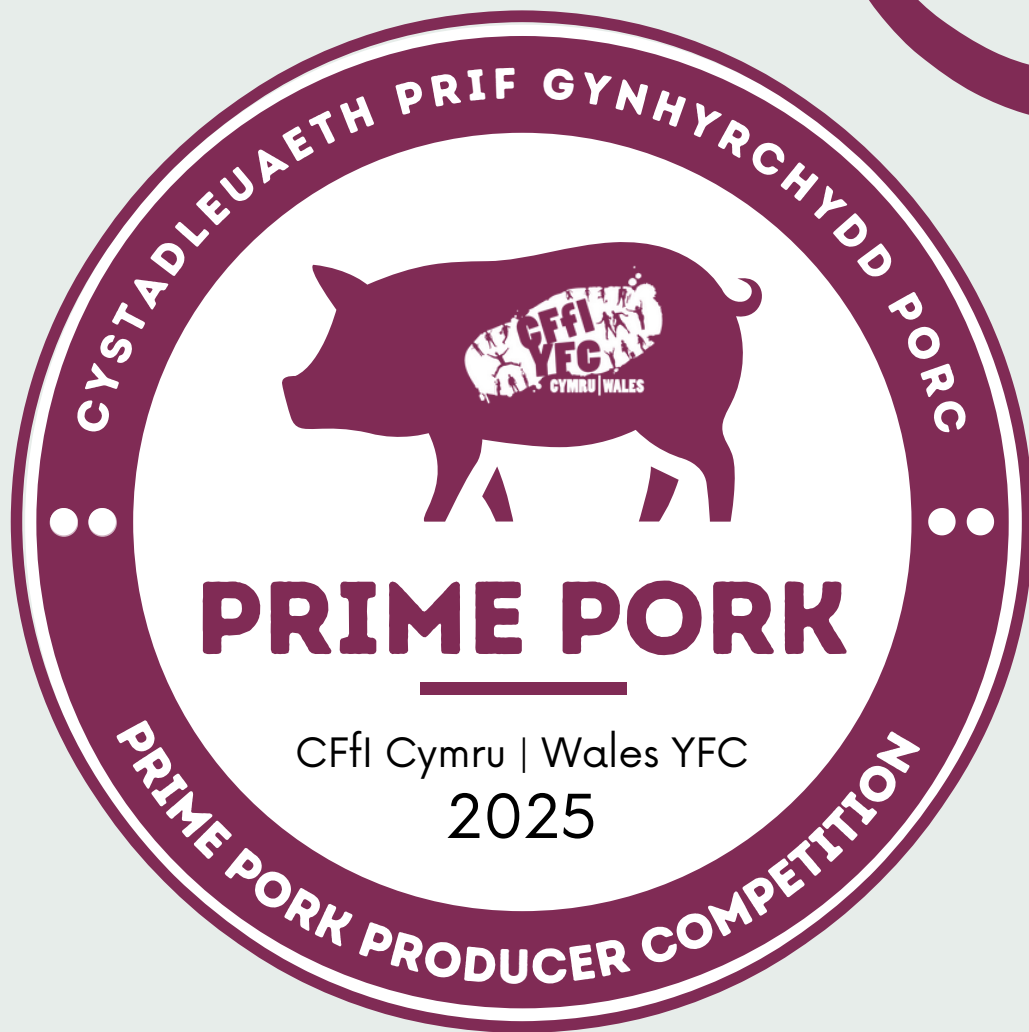
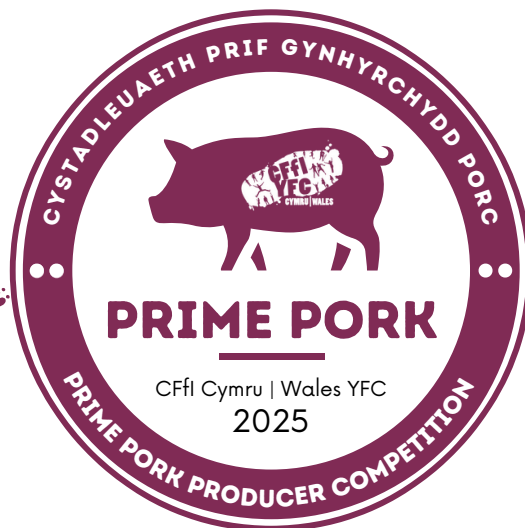

Disgrifiad Byr o Cystadleuaeth Prif Cynhyrchwr Porc CFFI Cymru 2025

Bydd yr aelodau llwyddiannus yn derbyn 4 mochyn diddyfnu tua 8 wythnos oed. Gofynnir i gystadleuwyr besgi'r moch yn barod i'w harddangos yn Ffair Aeaf Cymru 2025 ac yna bydd o leiaf un o'r moch yn cael ei ladd a'i feirniadu. Bydd enillydd cyffredinol y gystadleuaeth yn cael ei wobrwyo ar yr 17eg o Ionawr 2026 yng Ngwobrau Amaeth CFFI Cymru.

Rhan 1 - Magu a Phesgu y Moch

Bydd pob cystadleuwr llwyddiannus yn derbyn 4 mochyn unwaith bod y beirniaid wedi cytuno bod ganddynt safle priodol i gadw'r moch yn ystod y gystadleuaeth. Er mwyn gwarantu hyn bydd gofyn i'r cystadleuwyr anfon clip fidio o'u cyfleusterau gyda'u ffurflen gais. Bydd rhaid i'r cystadleuwyr mynychu diwrnodau hyfforddiant a chwblhau uned o hyfforddiant ar lein a ddarperir gan Gyswllt Ffermio cyn medru arddangos y moch yn Ffair Aeaf 2025. Bydd gofyn i'r cystadleuwyr pwyso eu moch bob pythefnos er mwyn dangos cynnydd a chyflwyno adroddiad byr ar ddiwedd bob mis (Mis Medi, Hydref a Thachwedd). Yn y Ffair Aeaf bydd gofyn i'r cystadleuwyr arddangos y wybodaeth yma am eu moch ar fwrdd arddangos 3ft x 3ft (Display board) e.e. dyddiad geni, brid, gwybodaeth am y bwyd y moch, graff i ddangos pwysau, lle cadw, a.y.b.

Rhan 2 – Arddangos y Moch yn y Ffair Aeaf

Bydd yna ddwy gystadleuaeth y gellid cystadlu ynddo:

- 1.Mochyn Sengl Gorau CFFI (hyd at 85kg)
- 2.Pâr Gorau o Foch CFFI (hyd at 85kg yr un)

Gall y cystadleuwyr ddod a 3 mochyn i'r Ffair Aeaf (1 i arddangos yn y Mochyn Unigol Gorau CFFI a 2 i arddangos yn y Pâr o Foch Gorau CFFI) NEU gall y cystadleuwyr ddod a 2 fochyn i'r Ffair Aeaf (2 mochyn i arddangos yn y Pâr o Foch Gorau CFFI a defnyddio un o rain ar gyfer arddangos yn Fochyn Unigol Gorau CFFI). Bydd hawl gan y cystadleuwyr gystadlu yng nghystadlaethau moch agored y Ffair Aeaf hefyd ond bydd rhaid cofrestru trwy system Ffair Aeaf CAFC a fydd yn gost ychwanegol i'r cystadleuwyr. Gall y cystadleuwyr werthu tri o'r moch fydd wedi cael ei harddangos yn y Ffair Aeaf neu eu mynd a nhw adref ond bydd rhaid i un o'r pedwar mochyn cael eu lladd yn rhan 3 o'r gystadleuaeth.

Rhan 3 - Lladd y Moch a Beirniadu

Bydd yn ofynnol i gystadleuwyr ladd o leiaf un o'r moch yn dilyn y Ffair Aeaf. Yna bydd y moch yn cael eu pwyso a'u barnu. Dim ond am ladd un mochyn bydd CFFI Cymru yn talu. Os yw'r cystadleuwyr yn dymuno torri'r carcasai i'w gwerthu i gwsmeriaid, bydd hyn yn gost ychwanegol i'r cystadleuwyr, neu os yw'r cystadleuwyr yn dymuno lladd mwy nag 1 o'r moch, bydd hyn hefyd yn gost ychwanegol i'r cystadleuydd. Gweler isod wefan ddefnyddiol ynglŷn â chanllawiau ar gyfer cadw Moch yng Nghymru.

Short Description of Wales YFC Prime Pork Producer Competition 2025

The successful members will receive 4 weaner pigs around 8 weeks old. The competitors will be asked to fatten the pigs ready to be exhibited at the Welsh Winter Fair 2025 and then at least one of the pigs will be slaughtered and judged. The overall winner of the competition will be announced on the 17th of January 2026 at the Wales YFC Agri Awards.

Part 1 – Rear and Fatten the Pigs

The successful members will receive 4 pigs each, once the judge is happy that they have a suitable place for the pigs to be housed and reared. This information will need to be sent in by video showing what facilities they have. The competitors will have to attend training and complete an unit of training provided by Cyswllt Ffermio before they can compete at the Welsh Winter Fair 2025. The competitors will also be asked to weigh their pigs every two weeks and submit a short report at the end of every month (September, October and November). At the Winter Fair the competitors will be asked to display this information on a 3ft x 3ft display board. e.g. date of birth, breed, information on feed, graph to show daily liveweight gain, housing, costings etc.

Part 2 – Exhibit the pigs at the Welsh Winter Fair

You will be eligible to compete in two competitions:

- 1.YFC Best Single Pig (up to 85kg)
- 2.YFC Best Pair of Pigs (up to 85kg each)

Competitors can bring 3 of the pigs to the Winter Fair (1 pig to be exhibited in the YFC Best Single Pig and 2 to be exhibited in the YFC Best Pair of Pigs) OR competitors can bring 2 of the pigs to the Winter Fair (2 pigs to be exhibited in the YFC Best Pair of Pigs and one of these Pigs can then be exhibited in the YFC Best Single Pig). You will also be allowed to compete in the Open Pig classes at the Winter Fair but you will have to enter through the Royal Welsh Winter Fair online system at your own cost. Competitors could sell two pigs that were exhibited at the Winter Fair or take them home but 1 out of the 4 pigs must be slaughtered for part 3 of the competition.

Part 3 – Slaughter the Pigs and Judging

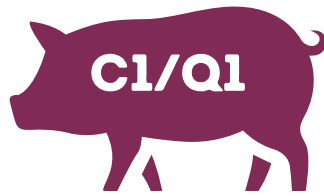
Competitors will be required to slaughter at least one of the pigs following the Winter Fair. The pigs will then be weighed and judged.

Wales YFC will only pay for slaughtering one of the pigs. If the competitor wishes to have the carcasses cut up to be sold to customers this will be an extra cost on the competitor, or if the competitor wish to slaughter more than 1 of the pigs this will also be an extra cost on the competitor.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Open to members of the Wales Federation of YFC. 16+
2. Competitors must be 28 years of age or under on the 1st September 2025. Competitors will be required to show their membership cards.
3. Failure to produce a valid membership card (with photo) will result in a £10 penalty charge. Any member whose name is not listed as a current paid-up member of the Federation and who cannot produce a membership card at the start of the competition will not be allowed to compete.
4. If members under 16 want to compete their parents or guardian will have to be present in all training sessions.

ENTRIES

5. Members will be automatically entered into the Wales YFC Single Pig and Wales YFC Pair of Pigs competition. The members will be able to enter the Open Pig Classes at the Royal Welsh Winter Fair via Royal Welsh Winter Fair Portal.

COMPETITION DETAILS

6. Maximum weight for the pigs is 85kg each.
7. The competition closing date is 23rd of June 2025. No late entries can be accepted.
8. The successful contestants will be announced on Tuesday the 22nd of July at the Royal Welsh Show.
9. The 5 successful members will be asked to pay a deposit of £100 by 12:00pm on the 11th of August 2025. The deposit will be refunded after the pigs have been exhibited at the Welsh Winter Fair 2025 and one of the pigs have been slaughtered as a part of the competition.



PROCEDURE

10. Members will be asked to complete an information sheet regarding themselves and the pigs before the Winter Fair and will need to be submitted by Sunday the 23rd. Information will be used by the commentator during the showing. Information Sheet
 11. Pigs to arrive at the Royal Welsh Winter Fair on Sunday 23th November, between 9.00am and 2.00pm. Pigs will be penned in a dedicated YFC section, as appointed by the Stewards.
 12. All judging will take place at the Royal Welsh Winter Fair, Llanelwedd on the 24th and 25th November, 2025. Pigs must not leave the show until after the sale on the 25th November, 2025.
 13. Competitors have the option to be supported by a 'sponsor', such as a breed society or association, local business, a marketing organisation or other industry supporter.
 14. Each competitor will be provided with an area to erect a board in which they are requested to present details about their pigs, including:
 - i. all relevant costings,
 - ii. details of feed,
 - iii. information regarding their sponsor (if applicable).
- Maximum size of board; 3ft x 3ft.
15. During the Winter Fair, all competitors will be required to present their pigs in the ring for judging. Two persons, the competitor and one further member 28 years of age or under to show the pigs. Membership cards for both members will be required to be shown during the competition.
 16. Rosettes will be awarded to the 'Supreme Champion YFC Single Pig' and 'Supreme Champion YFC Pair of Pigs'.
 17. Competitors have the option of entering their pigs into the auction. It is the responsibility of the member to inform the sale auctioneers of any reserves they wish to place on the animals. It is the members' responsibility to present their pigs to the sale ring when required.
 18. The YFC Champion Single Pig and YFC Champion Pair of Pigs must be offered for sale.
 19. Please note that the Wales YFC general rules and RWAS general rules apply to this competition.
